Registration Fee:

Stock Sheet:

Please ensure that you have two copies of your coded stock on your stock sheet which must both be handed to the Sales Manager when you bring in your work on Wednesday 26th June 11am – 8pm.

You are advised to keep another copy of your completed sheet for your own reference.

If, at any time during Star Glaze, you remove work from display, or add work to it, this must be marked on your submitted Stock Sheet at the Sales desk and the Sales Manager informed. You are advised to keep an updated/amended copy of your completed sheet for your own reference.

Labelling:

Each piece of work needs to be individually labelled with Your 3-letter identification code, eg, OPC and The identifying number of your work; no # please, just the number The price. You can add a brief description if space allows, eg, blue bowl. NO other numbers or letters please, our system does not allow for them. Labels are of your own choosing: ie they can be laminated and tied on or stuck on, if

Some exhibitors might like to use their own business cards and create labels on the reverse. We do emphasise that labelling of your items is your own responsibility and is most important. Any incorrectly or unlabelled items will be withdrawn from the festival to avoid confusion

Previous exhibitors please use the same code as last year. 3 letters first, then number.

Your Display Space:

Your area is yours to set up. If you have your own trestle tables, please bring them. Any display used must be of a professional standard. Think what you may need for this, table cloths, display supports, Matariki inspiration and influence, stands or boxes to lift work, plinths, etc. Star Glaze is an upmarket event.

Spaces are approx. 2m long x1.8 deep.

Trestle tables are available at \$10 each Display panels for wall display : 2400 X1200 \$40; 1200 X1200 \$20.

Commission rate

There will be a 15% commission charged on the retail price of all items sold. We have continued with this special rate for 2023, in light of the difficult times we all are facing. This will be calculated at the time of sale. Full details of work sold and payments will be sent to you once Star Glaze is over, approximately two weeks after the final day. We are GST registered.
